



Q2 What impact do you think the overhaul of teacher training, and particularly the launch of Schools Direct, has had on the quality of teachers entering the profession?





































Q21 To what extent does the new national curriculum enable teachers to introduce greater rigour and challenge as the rationale for the change suggests?






